and behoof forever and the said Nicholas Pyle for himself his heirs and  
assigns - do and will ever warrant the right and title of the same  
to the said Kirkpatrick against myself and heirs and assigns and against  
any other person who may claim the same - Provided further therefore  
that if the said Nicholas Pyle his heirs administrators and assigns shall  
will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Kirkpatrick his heirs and  
assigns the aforementioned note with the sum mentioned thereon with the lawful  
interest thereon at the time mentioned and approved for the payment thereof when  
and from thence forth as well the interest and the rights to the property  
thus conveyed at the said sum or for notes shall bear as between me and him
