A.D. 1855 between Nicholas Pyle of the Shelly County Alabama
Wheeler of the first part & R. J. Wheeler of the same state and County
of the second part. Witnesseth that I Land N. Pyle for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred & 15⁰⁰ dollars to me
in hand paid the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge have
bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant
Bargain sell and deliver unto the said R. J. Wheeler his heirs
to a certain tract or piece of land known as the S E $\frac{1}{4}$ of
S E $\frac{1}{4}$ & the S E $\frac{1}{4}$ of N E $\frac{1}{4}$ & the N E $\frac{1}{4}$ of S E $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 40 33 T 18
R 2 E in the district of Tuskeggee & State of Ala containing
One hundred and twenty acres more or less to him the
said Wheeler his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the above
described land and premises with all the appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and I
the land party of the first part myself my heirs Executors
Advers and Assigns to warrant him and former defend
the rights of the aforesaid land to the said Wheeler his
heirs and assigns against the claim of the United
States and the claim of all manner of persons whatever
claiming through by or under the same whether in
law or equity the witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this date above written

The foregoing deed of conveyance is on this Esqup Con
dition viz that should the said Nicholas Pyle by the first
day of January 1857 pay to said R. J. Wheeler the sum of one hundred
& 15⁰⁰ dollars good and lawful money with interest added
theron at eight per cent per annum then the above
Conveyance to be null and void to all intents
and purposes but should the said Pyle fail to pay
the aforesaid amount to said Wheeler by the said
stipulated time then the right of onto the aforesaid
premises held by said Wheeler absolutely and the
said N. Pyle binds myself to pay him (Wheeler) in
one payable and actual proportion of the same without
any just prouys or hindrance whatever notwithstanding
I have and seal this 24 day of September A.D. 1855
