I know all men by these that I May Ann Pile of the
County of Shelby & State of Kentucky in consideration
of the sum of sixty dollars in hand paid by B W
Elliott the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained & sold by these presents do bargain
sell & deliver unto the said Elliott the following
property to wit; One Black Mare bought of
G W M Grant, also twenty Pairs of Store Hogs
& twenty Head of Sheep & 8 head of Cattle
to have and to hold said property from me my heirs
or assigns as his own right & property to all intents
& purposes. But to hold said property upon trust
nevertheless that if the said May Ann Pile shall
pay or cause to be paid a certain note of hand
for sixty dollars given by her to G W M Grant, dated
May 12th 1859 & due the 25th day of next December
to which said note I am bound, whenever said
note shall become due, or be demanded, then this
obligation to be null & void and of no effect in law
but if not to remain in full force & virtue.
