

also from the time of making said application, now  
 comes the said administrator and moves the court  
 that said application be granted; And it appear-  
 ing to the satisfaction of the court from proper evidence  
 that due notice of the filing of said application and  
 that the same would this day of be heard and return  
 has been duly given and that Geo. Pyles, Sallie Cates and  
 her husband James Cates, Eliza Pyles, adult heirs and  
 distributees residing in his state have been duly notified  
 of the filing of said application, and of the day set  
 for hearing the same by citations issued and duly  
 served upon them not less than ten days before this  
 day, and that William Pyles and Doxey Pyles, Sallie  
 Pyles, Mr Fullmer, and Henry Pyles, Eb. Pyles, Sam Pyles,  
 Mary Pyles, and Alice Pyles, and James Fullmer, husband  
 of Mr Fullmer, have been duly notified of said appli-  
 cation and of the day set for hearing said the same,  
 by publication <sup>for three consecutive weeks</sup> of a notice to them directed in  
 the Knoxville Herald a newspaper published  
 in said Clout County, and thereby brought into court  
 according to law, the court now proceeds to hear  
 said application.

And it appearing to the court from the allegations  
 contained in said application and from the depositions  
 of G. S. Bradford and D. G. Fullmer, disinterested  
 witnesses taken upon interrogatories and submitted  
 by the petitioner as in, Chancery cases, which depositions  
 are ordered to filed and recorded, that the lands  
 mentioned and described in said application  
 of which the said deceased died seized and  
 possessed, viz: The North West quarter, and also the  
 East half of South West quarter of North West quarter of
